MARKING SYSTEM: Sportident (not Air)

In case of failure of the SI unit, the competitor marks the passage of a control by replacement mechanical stamping anywhere on the map and he points out this fact immediately at the finish line and hands over the map to the finish referee.

PRIZES AND CEREMONIES:

144MHz CLASSIC : First three competitors in each category will receive a certificate of award.

3,5MHz CLASSIC : First three competitors in each category will receive a certificate of award

SPRINT : First three competitors in each category will receive a certificate of award and medals.

FOXORING: First three competitors in each category will receive a certificate of award and medals.

OVERALL: First three competitors in each category will receive certificate of award and commemorative prices. (The smallest sum of placements from all stages)

INFORMATION:

We kindly ask all participants to separate trash in finish areas to individual trash cans. Also not to crush plastic bottles.

Draft beer and Kofola will be available at the finish area for free. Each competitor will receive a ticket for one meal at the finish.

We will provide transportation of baggage from start to finish on every stage.

Medical personnel will be available to treat any minor injuries in the finish area on every stage. However, all participants must have valid insurance.

Start numbers must be worn on all stages and competitors must make sure that the start number is visibly mounted on the chest.

PARKING: Coordinates of primary parking lot: 48.6496606N, 18.5842861E

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION: Hilly, rugged terrain, mostly open forest with very good visibility. The terrain features numerous rock towers, rock cliffs and walls, stone blocks, stone fields, and several smaller rock formations. The running surface varies from very good to challenging and unpleasant scree. In parts of the terrain, there are landslide features (small valleys, depressions, plateaus, mounds) that enhance the rocky sections of this area. We strongly recommend spikes and taping your ankles for both days of the competition.

REGISTRATION: All competitors not registered the day before must register in the event center (coordinates above). Competitors with accommodation will be informed about their accommodation and room numbers. Their keys from rooms will be handed over at their accommodation after the race from either receptionist or Slovakia Open staff member.

Please take into account that registration might take up to 10 minutes!

QUARANTINE: 15 minutes before start 00 any entrance to and from the start area will be forbidden. **Competitors must be present in the start area 15 minutes before start 00.** Finish quarantine will not be held but we ask competitors for fair play behavior.

HANDING OVER RECEIVERS: Until 15:20 - competitors who disobey this rule may be disqualified from the race. Receivers will be collected at the start area.

CORRIDORS: Corridor from S: 100m

Finish corridor: 150 m, Corridor is crossing a small shallow creek, please pay extra attention while crossing.

Route to start will be marked from finish area with stripes. Distance 400m.

EVENT COORDINATES: 48.8587197N, 18.6097378E

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION: Challenging orienteering rugged terrain with numerous low ground formations. Many light thickets are present. A system of streams runs across the map, overflowing in places and creating marshes. This part may be difficult to traverse. We advise you to use numerous footpaths.

BUS TRANSPORTATION: On this day, buses from the accommodation to the start area and from the finish area back to accommodation, will be provided for the competitors. Departure times will be adjusted based on the starting list. It is strictly prohibited to enter the bus in spike shoes! Walking from finish to bus approx. 400m.

HANDING OVER RECEIVERS: Right after arriving to start area – competitors who disobey this rule may be disqualified from the race

LENGTH OF FINISH CORRIDOR: Around 100m

NOTES: Fast foxes will have the same flag as normal foxes.

Some meadows around the start may contain electric fences which are not on the map. These meadows are for horses. Do not cross these fences!

MAP: Bojnice, 1:10 000, period: 2011, partial revision 2024, h=5m, A4, not waterproof

EVENT COORDINATES: 48.7982086N, 18.5780458E

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION: Mixed high forest with multiple mountain ranges present on the map, some of which are very steep. Fairly great road network in the main part. Southern edge contains a fenced private area of local viewpoint.

BUS TRANSPORTATION: : On this day, buses from the accommodation to the start area and from the finish area back to accommodation, will be provided for the competitors. Departure times will be adjusted based on the starting list. It is strictly prohibited to enter the bus in spike shoes! Walking from finish to bus approx. 500m.

HANDING OVER RECEIVERS: Right after arriving to start area – competitors who disobey this rule may be disqualified from the race

LENGTH OF FINISH CORRIDOR: Around 150 m

NOTES: Road nr. 1774 is forbidden to run on! It will be marked on map with crosses (711.0-forbidden route). Prohibition of crossing electric fences. Do not enter trimmed lawns, gardens and private properties near the cottages and buildings! Bike trails are located in the competition area. Be careful when crossing them and lookout for bikes.

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION: Hilly, rugged terrain, mostly open forest with very good visibility. The terrain features numerous rock towers, rock cliffs and walls, stone blocks, stone fields, and several smaller rock formations. The running surface varies from very good to challenging and unpleasant scree. In parts of the terrain, there are landslide features (small valleys, depressions, plateaus, mounds) that enhance the rocky sections of this area. We strongly recommend spikes and taping your ankles for both days of the competition.

QUARANTINE: 15 minutes before start 00 any entrance to and from the start area will be forbidden. **Competitors must be present in the start area 15 minutes before start 00.** Finish quarantine will not be held but we ask competitors for fair play behavior. Receivers will not be collected.

LENGTH OF FINISH CORRIDOR: 150 m, Corridor is crossing a small shallow creek, please pay extra attention while crossing.

NOTES: Calling to pre-start is -4min.

Route to start will be marked from the finish area with stripes. Distance 1000m.

RULES: The competition will follow standard international rules of ARDF competitions based on the IARU.
